## Other Comments on the Thesis

The thesis deals with interesting topic Lean management in public sector. The theoretical part is well written based on numerous resources mainly from research studies. It contains theoretical statements of lean management and lean tools with special focus on lean in public sector, more specifically healthcare.

To fulfil the goal of the thesis, the author conducted a secondary research based on the resources published in the Google Scholar database regarding the lean application in the healthcare sector in the practical part. Author identified and used 23 articles for analysis and confirmed that it is possible to find application of Lean management in the public sector, namely in the healthcare. In content analysis author focused on tools that were used in healthcare units, objectives of the study, methodology and key findings of the study. However, this information is very brief, lacking greater depth of analysis. Next, author choose 10 articles to identify benefits and 10 articles to identify challenges of lean application in healthcare. Again, the presented information is too general. The material would be more beneficial if it had been more precise and detailed.

The thesis has formal errors:

- Table of contents: there is writ. ten "Error" instead of page for chapter 4.4, also font formatting is not same for whole Table of contents.
- Page 7: the source related to figure 1 is mentioned incorrectly two times.
- Page 43: Figure 5 is wrong.
- Page 27: author mentions 5 articles are used, but on page 45 is written 10 articles are used. There is mistake on page 27.
- Page 60: There is written in conclusion "text twenty-one (23)" papers were used.
- etc.

It can be stated that the aim of the thesis has been fulfilled.

## Comments on the Outputs from the Theses System

It is original work, there is no sign of plagiarism. The compliance with other existing documents is no higher than 2 %.

## Questions and Suggestions for Defence

1. Can you name lean management tool (or tools), that is not mentioned in analysed articles, but can be used by public sector organizations with great success?
2. Do you know any Czech healthcare sector organization that is using lean?
