### **Other Comments on the Thesis**

The student regularly took part in consultations and tried to follow the given recommendations.

The student was expected to propose how to compare countries from the point of view of their attractiveness. He included five determinants based on the literature review. He wanted to focus on the Central European Region; he included the Czech Republic, Lithuania, Hungary, Slovakia, Croatia, Poland, Bulgaria, Slovenia, and Serbia (see page 38).

He thoroughly described the development of particular determinants within a 5-years span for each country. A deeper analysis could be conducted.

I appreciate that he was able to learn how to visualize data using maps. He created several maps, just the content and used symbology could be richer. On the other hand, he should be more careful and use data with the same units in one map (see e.g. Fig. 4.7.2).

In chapter 4.6, he described the overall attractiveness of the countries. He does not describe the rules according to which he classifies countries as more or less attractive. This part of the thesis could be described deeper.
