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Other comments

The master thesis deals with data support for planning of reconstruction in conflict-affected areas with focus on Yemen.

The thesis and it elaboration has shown author's competence in this field. The main aim of the thesis was to design a suitable data set that would support process of redevelopment of the country after a forced conflict. Author provides description of processes of reconstruction and post-conflict state restoration and peacebuilding. Next, he proposes a model for reconstruction after a disaster. The proposal is followed by available data collection, a brief evaluation of data sources and very brief proposal of a data set.

The thesis shows that author was able to meet the given objective, solve the given tasks by himself and apply previously learned knowledge and skills although some parts (namely the 3rd and 4th items from the outline given by thesis assignment, i.e. chap. 5) should be more detailed to better fulfil the aim.

There are several formal mistakes, e.g. appendices are not numbered, formatting of list of references is not unified, etc.

Author usually worked with his own initiative but not regularly. He responded to most of my comments, except for the above mentioned issues.
