Unfortunately, she did not keep the unified structure of the analyses. The researched fields are slightly different in selected countries. It decreases relevance of outputs and recommendations of the thesis. Nevertheless, the analyses led to description of main problems of the policies implemented in the selected Sub-Sahara countries. Student also delivered relevant suggestions for further policies implementation. The formal aspects of the thesis are satisfactory.

## Comments on the Outputs from the Theses System

The maximum resemblance to other sources is 22% to the previous version of the thesis. The maximum resemblance to other sources is lower than 5%. There was no plagiarism identified.
