### Other comments

The thesis provides an interesting insight into development issues of selected countries in Africa. I can imagine that it is quite challenging to work on this topic, given the availability of data.

I do, however, have a few critical notes, in particular:

- The thesis provides an overview of development policies in selected African countries, but I am not sure that in all cases we can really talk about regional development policies (i.e., policies with a strong territorial dimension that are also aimed at the issue of territorial disparity).
- I don't understand why the sample of interviewers is being compared to samples from other studies that are unrelated to the topic. Specifically, the samples are compared in terms of "personal" data (e.g. sex, educational attainment, etc.).
- The student did not use any of the resources recommended in the assignment.

# Questions and suggestions for the defence

- 1) You have not used any of the resources recommended in the assignment. Why?
- 2) Following the issue of corruption in financing, you suggest that mechanisms need to be put in place to help ensure efficiency and accountability. Can you be more specific, please? I.e., how do you imagine such a mechanism?
