## Otázky/Questions:

- 1) ZM: the tension between legalism & constructivism, with regards to "reasonableness"
- 2) ZM: (how) does "reasonableness" guarantee the inclusion of basic liberal principles?
- 3) JJ: the relevance of neuroscience in the argument
- 4) JJ: how is the role of liberty anchored in the examples (Romania in Balkans)?
- 5) JJ: the importance of teleology; the difference betw. Aristotle & modern theorists
- 6) OB: the importance of "we" as a foundation of what counts as "reasonable"
- 7) PL: if "reasonableness" is the objective moral quality, why is it so historically late & contingent?  
+ (un)reasonableness & embeddedness in a historical context, in view of "progress"
- 8) audience: the importance of perspective/the description under which - influence on what counts as reasonable
- 9) audience: moral & political concerns may not be reason-based (emotions, pain-avoidance, ...)
